# SNIP SNOWFLAKES

Did you know that every snowflake has a different design and pattern? Follow these directions to make your own unique snowflakes. Once you have created multiple designs, hang them up to create your own Land of Snowflakes!



Begin with a square sheet of paper and fold to create a triangle.



Fold your triangle in half to create a smaller triangle.



Fold your smaller triangle in half to create the smallest triangle.



Cut the bottom of your paper in a straight line to create an isosceles triangle, meaning two of the sides are equal.



Cut small shapes into your folded paper and unfold when you've finished to reveal a unique winter wonder!




Thread multiple snowflakes together and hang them on a wall or windowsill to create a snow-filled winter landscape!

Begin with one dot in the middle, then drag your finger in a straight line away from the center dot to make long petals.



# **TULIP**


DAISY

# HIBISCUS

Create loops to make petals and layer with as many colors as you'd like. Then, add a stripe with a dot at the end from the middle.






### **PEONY**

Start by making short strokes in a circular direction, then layer other colors on top of your circle in the same fashion. Add some quick dots in the middle to finish.
